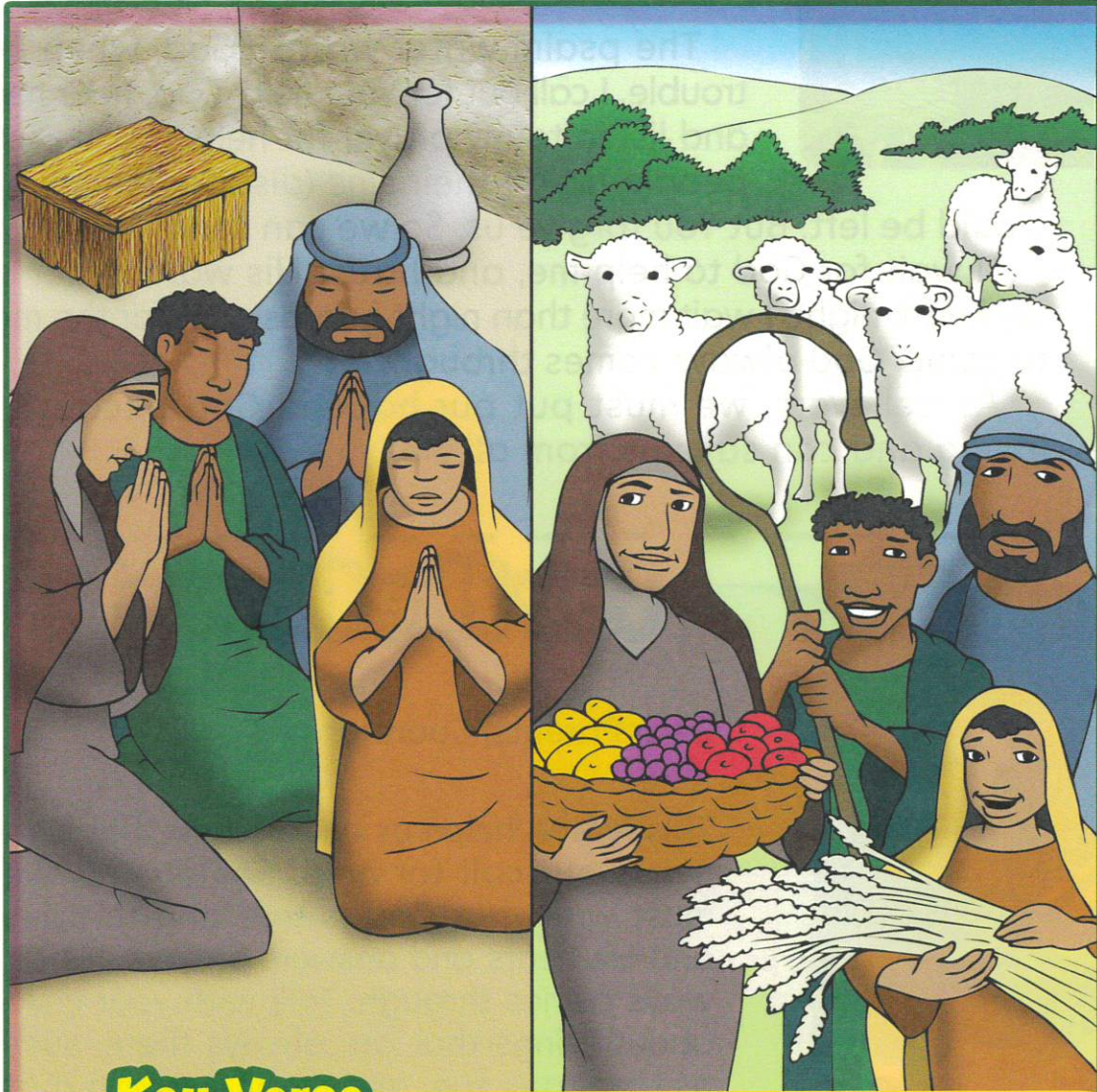

He Always Comes Through

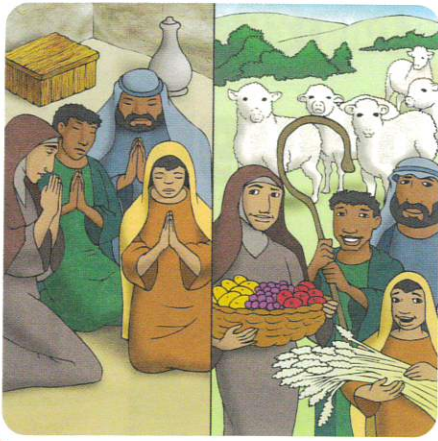
Lesson Scripture: Psalm 130:1-8



Key Verse

I wait for the LORD, my whole being waits, and in his word I put my hope. (Psalm 130:5)





He Always Comes Through

(Psalm 130:1-8)

The psalm writer wrote, "God, when I am in trouble, I call out for Your help. God, hear my voice and listen to my prayer for help. If You punished people for all their *sins* (disobedience), no one would be left. But You forgive us. So we can serve You.

"I wait for God to help me, and I trust His word. After a long and dark night, I wait more than night guards wait for the morning to come. God always comes through."

As believers, we must put our hope in God because He is loving and can save us from all sin.

For the Parents

Dear Parents/Guardians,

This lesson helps us understand that God hears our call for help. Sometimes, we must wait—but God is true and faithful, and He hears and answers prayers. He always comes through. Talk with your child about things that are always there, such as the stars, sun, and moon. Explain that God is always around like those things He created. But even better, God loves us and is there when we need Him.
